

Amongst the Blooms

During this one-day session I will demonstrate a variety of loose florals and how adding some key elements/details will make them bloom! These blooms will be suitable for greeting cards and calligraphic projects of your choice.



Supplies:

½" Flat watercolour brush,
A few of round brushes sizes 5 or 6 and a smaller size 2 or 4.
2H pencil and sharpener

Watercolours: pan or tube of your choice.

I am including palettes of colours I frequently use. I like to have two of each colour, light and a darker in a yellow, greens, pinks, reds and blues. Work with what you have.

Watercolour paper: If you have pieces of hot and cold press paper you can experiment with which surface you prefer.

Canson XL watercolour paper is a good readily available option.

Work with at least 9"x12" size pages.

Favourite practise paper that will accept wet media for initial stroke practise.
