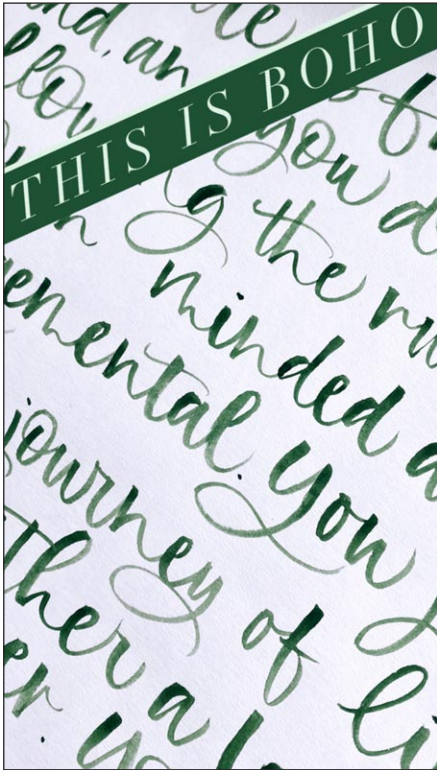

### 1. Boho Script - Free Spirit Letters with a mini brush *with Aspacia Kukulas*

**Description:** Learn brush calligraphy to create long texts and phrases. Boho script is a more relaxed and modern style to apply in different applications such as cards and artistic compositions! In this class you will enjoy the lowercase alphabet, exercises will be practiced to have a better understanding of the brush, its control, technique, what are the different types of strokes and how to execute them, correct shapes and proportions of the letters, etc. We will also practice how to make variations of the original model to create a dynamic and expressive alphabet.

**Supplies to bring:**

- Round brush size 10/0, 12/0 or up to 18/0 (ideally a short bristle brush)
- Gouache or watercolor
- Container with water
- Practice paper (resistant to water)

**Supply fee to be paid in class to teacher: \$12.00**

Includes handouts and watercolor sheet for a final piece

### 2. Souvenir Bracelet

*with Matilda Maestas*

Inspired by Zentangle® designs, tole-painting, or whatever art method you choose, these wooden craft bracelets will become your souvenirs from this year's LCS conference.

After a long day in class, come relax and have fun designing your bracelet.

**Supplies to bring:**

- Pencil for pre-design (if needed)
- Micron pen .05
- Paint brush(es) (if you wish to paint on your bracelet)
- Acrylic paints if you choose to use (I will have some Americana brand)

**Supplies provided:** I will supply the bracelets (I have extras), acrylic paints, disposable palettes, some bling-bling (little rhinestones) if you wish to use them.

### 3. Iris Folding

*with Anna Biggs*

In this mini class, you will learn the technique of iris folding – laying folded strips of decorative paper down in a spiral pattern to form a dimensional image in a cut-out opening on a piece of cardstock. The small opening left in the center of the pattern is the iris, and traditionally filled with holographic or sparkly paper,

#### Supplies provided:

Cardstock, envelopes, patterns and decorative paper for everybody

#### Supplies to bring:

- Scissors
- Repositionable or low-tack tape
- Permanent regular scotch tape
- Double sided permanent tape

Supply fee to be paid in class to teacher: \$5

Please note: actual colors of projects will vary from the photograph.



#### Supplies to bring:

- Pencil • Eraser • Scissors
- Glue Stick • Ruler • Bone folder

**Materials charge: \$5** for collage materials, magazines, maps, calendars, tags, washi tape, yarn, fibers, ribbon, punches, die cuts, brads, buttons, etc, etc, etc.

**Optional:** Bring ephemera about YOUR wish!

Examples - small photos, tickets, fortunes, wrappers from your favorite coffee, tea, or chocolate, maps, etc.

Supply fee to be paid in class to teacher: \$5

### 4. Make-a-Wish Book

*with Marjorie Grace-Sayers*

Playful one-of-a-kind book made from one sheet of paper with 3 pockets for tags and 1 pocket for a small booklet (zine). The zine is a smaller version of the big book.

#### Materials:

One large sheet of 14" x 17" (or 12" x 18", 12" x 16", or 18" x 24") paper as we will be folding it - Arches Text wove, very thin poster board, manilla, thick drawing paper, 90# watercolor, art paper, sulfite paper, etc.

One slightly smaller sheet - 12 x 15" or 12" x 12" (scrapbook paper, Manila folder, or any of the papers above)

\* You can also recycle a piece of your own work - only one side will be visible.

\* Don't stress about the paper size—we can cut it BEFORE we fold it.

\* The book will be 1/2 the height of the paper AND 1/4 of the width:

So: 14" x 17" paper = 7" H x 4 1/4" W booklet

12" x 18" paper = 6" H x 4 1/2" W booklet, etc.
