ABOUT THE PROGRAM

How to design, draw, watercolor Poppies - California Poppies are the state flower and they come in a variety of colors. To study them is to revel in their feathery leaves and color. Mina Taylor will teach us how to watercolor and interlace them with a monoline alphabet she is calling: Morse-Deco.

ABOUT MINA

Mina Taylor has practiced calligraphy for over 40 years. For 20 years she ran an art show featuring 25 artists from southern California. In 1979, she founded and launched her calligraphic business: Mina's Manuscripts & More. Taking on students and limited commissions, her current work can be seen at [minas.manuscripts](https://www.instagram.com/minas.manuscripts) on Instagram. She draws inspiration and text from the Bible, which she has found to be an anchor in her own life. "I believe that calligraphic words of truth can inspire people in transition, in grief, in hopelessness, in joy, in all of life really- to think beyond their situation to eternal things."

SUPPLY LIST:

- Watercolors: Any set of watercolors.
COLORS: Greens (several shades if possible - although we will talk about mixing colors) Blue, Orange, Yellow, White, Red, Tan or Brown
- At least 2-3 water color brushes with a fine tip. # 1, 2 3 and/or 4.
- A dark ink which will not run when it is re-wet. Golden acrylic could work or watered down acrylic craft paint. It needs to not run when rewet because we will be placing our poppies on top of the letters.
- A B nib (this is a round ended nib) Preferably a B-2 and holder to insert it. Or if you want to do it the easy way a medium tip Sharpie.
- Water color paper at least 90#. It can be cold or hot press. Cold press will render more texture.
- Water for painting
- Paper towels

This program is open to both members and non-members. Feel free to bring a friend, just be sure they are registered.
